19 years ago, on September 11, 2001, America was attacked by terrorists that crashed into the Twin Towers in New York's business district. It was unbelievable!

September 11 attacks, also called **9/11 attacks**, series of [airline hijackings](#) and suicide attacks committed in 2001 by 19 militants associated with the Islamic extremist group [al-Qaeda](#) against targets in the [United States](#), the deadliest terrorist

attacks on American soil in U.S. history. The attacks against [New York City](#) and [Washington, D.C.](#), caused extensive death and destruction and triggered an enormous U.S. effort to combat [terrorism](#). Some 2,750 people were killed in New York, 184 at the [Pentagon](#), and 40 in [Pennsylvania](#) (where one of the hijacked planes crashed after the passengers attempted to retake the plane); all 19 terrorists died. Police and fire departments in New York were especially hard-hit: hundreds had rushed to the scene of the attacks, and more than 400 police officers and firefighters were killed.
