

In 2008, I was taking care of my dear father, Elder Minor Palm, Jr. He was 82 years old at that time. He was living here with Simmie and me. I truly had my hands full taking care of two very dear men in my life. However, it was an honor.

At that time, I had several responsibilities and many things to do in my ministry. I was actively involved with the writers' guild editing manuscripts and poetry. Life was full of other demands, too.

On one evening in the end of summer, actually around the beginning of September, I was sitting at my computer working on some of my poetry. I believe I was reviewing some poems to submit to a magazine titled, Sistah Talk Ezine. The deadline was a few days away, but I wanted to be prepared to send in my work on time.

Daddy was quietly sitting in our living room reading and studying his Bible, as he usually enjoyed doing throughout the day. Simmie was in our bedroom watching television. He probably was stretched out across the bed relaxing. The house was so peaceful. There was a blanket of silence in the atmosphere. All was still. Nobody was calling out to me to do something for them.

So, I was happy to have this time for me to write and to read over old poems. Suddenly, I felt a strong presence of the Lord in the computer room. I sat very still. I was waiting to hear or see something happen. I could strongly feel the presence of the God....He was there, right there! He stood behind me. He said nothing...He reached

out and placed His right hand on my left shoulder. Oh, He was there. He stood there with His hand firmly on my shoulder. Tears ran down my face. I could barely remain seated.

Then, He spoke to me...

"Wanda. Wanda," He said.

"Yes, Lord?" I replied.

"Wanda, I have something to say. I want to speak to people," He said in a louder voice.

"Wanda, I want you to write a newsletter," God said in a very firm voice.

"I don't know what to do about a newsletter. I never wrote one. I never did that before. I have not done this. What can I do? Why...

"Wanda! I will speak and you will write what I want to say. When you write the newsletter, I will be here each time. I will help you."

Wow Wanda the newsletter was a heaven sent. This comes at such a perfect time. My grandmother went to be with the Lord on December 10, 2015. I was with her in the hospital for 22 days and nights. It had gotten to the point I was not getting enough rest in there to help her call the nurse, help feed her or whatever she needed do to me being so lethargic. So my aunt agreed to visit and spend the night with her and let me go home and get some rest. I asked her to do two things call me if grandma kept asking for me and watch her blood pressure. If her blood pressure dropped lower than 75 systolic call a nurse or get one. I got a text her blood pressure dropped to 32 - I am thinking what that is fatal. Rushed to the hospital to find her peacefully sleep. I could not believe it. The one time I leave her she slipped away.

A few said she was waiting on me to leave her bedside. I have gone back and forth with it. All I know is God gets the last say and now I am at peace. I was my grandmothers caregiver. Since 2009 I cared for her as my grandfather went to be with the Lord. We would take turns watching him. He had developed Alzheimers and sometimes would try to go out of the front door. He passed away at home in the kitchen at the table. My grandmother did not even know he was gone. She had asked me to see about him because he did not want to eat dinner. His last wishes and mostly my grandmothers wishes were met. I am in a daze. I have been thanking God for the experience of knowing my grandparents and being raised by them and the opportunity to help them as an adult as they helped me when I was a child. I thank God for being raised by a Christian mother and grandparents. I thank God for allowing me to express my love, gratitude and servitude toward my grandmother at home and in the hospital. The staff and everyone knew our love for each other and God was our Lord and Savior!


